DAY	FIRE & WATER	COOKING	CLEAN UP
Duties:	Gather plenty of fuel and firewood! Directed by the cooks, have proper number of fires lit, beds of charcoal ready at proper time, arrange & move grills and Dutch ovens for the cooks. Directed by Clean-up crew, refill all patrol water supplies, put wash water on the fire to heat after cooks are done, properly dispose of all dirty water, see that all fires are safely put OUT.	Read all cooking directions TWICE! Keep your hands and the meal preparation area CLEAN. Plan cooking times so that all food is ready to serve, fully cooked, at the same time. Serve to your patrol family style. You are responsible for having your patrol remember to say Grace and in leading your PATROL YELL just before each meal is served. You must pick up and properly dispose of all trash in the patrol site after each meal.	Set up Patrol wash stations using plastic basins and the hot water prepared by the Fire & Water Crew. Hot Soapy water in one, WEAK bleach water in second, Hot Clean Rinse water in third basin. EVERY MEMBER OF THE PATROL must clean his own plate, cup and utensils. Wipe out all food before washing. The Clean Up crew's job is to clean pots and pans used during meal preparation. They must also tidy up and properly stow gear in the Patrol Box.
